REACH Declaration of Conformity

Regarding Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 December 2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH).

As a distributor, importer, and manufacturer of products and parts (fasteners, connectors, screws, etc.), ETTINGER GmbH takes its information obligations under Article 33 of the REACH Regulation very seriously and we regularly ask our upstream suppliers to provide us with information in this regard.

The regulation obliges us to inform customers if a substance from the SVHC list is present in our products in excess of 0.1% by weight or if a restriction from Annex XVII applies.

According to the current SVHC candidate list (253 substances), SVHC substances exceeding 0.1% may be present in our products.

Products made of steel, brass, and aluminum may contain the SVHC substance lead (Pb) in excess of 0.1% by weight.

Lead is classified as toxic to reproduction. This does not mean, however, that there is an immediate danger from materials containing lead. It is therefore essential to consider this information and how it relates to the intended use.

Product-specific information on the materials used, RoHS and REACH conformity as well as SVHC can also be obtained from the product data sheets (available in PDF format) on our website www.ettinger.de at any time.

If the SVHC symbol appears in **red** and with an X (= *SVHC not compliant*), the specified product contains a substance from the SVHC candidate list exceeding 0.1%.

Please refer to the attached product list for the CAS numbers of the affected plastic products. For metal products, CAS number 7439-92-1 (Pb) applies. Screws with sealing rings that are listed in the SVHC list are excluded from this. In this case, CAS number 556-67-2 (D4) applies.
